

Radioactive Material Transport Users Committee

Terms of Reference February 2007

The Radioactive Material Transport Users committee (RAMTUC) is the industry's forum for development of strategy and policy regarding the regulations for the safe transport of radioactive material.

RAMTUC will:

Development

- develop, endorse and promote radioactive material training programmes
- hold nuclear industry DGSA/SMLO seminars to share experience of national and international regulations
- develop and share industry best practice, including regulatory guidance and interpretation
- administer centralised industry resources (such as the RAM approved carrier's list)

Representation

- agree a united approach to be taken in dealings with national and international regulatory and enforcement agencies
- raise the profile of the industry sector and the issues faced by members with regulatory agencies.
- Assist national authorities in the development of national and international regulations controlling the transport of radioactive material and in particular to try and ensure that these regulations reflect operational experience and commercial realities

Industry communication

- liaise with other groups and associations, such as Transport Container Standardisation Committee (TCSC) and RADSAFE
- collate and present annual committee reports to the nuclear industry Safety Directors Forum.
- Share learning from experience
